First semester lunch buddies(T/TH) ends on Thursday, January 12th and second semester begins without interruption the next week. If you only paid for first semester and want to continue Lunch Buddies, you will need to send in a check for second semester. Anyone already enrolled in BEARS, EAGLES, or AMIGOS, you are signed up for the year and do not need to do anything. The winter season is a wonderful time for children to explore the outdoors, but being prepared for the weather is half the battle.
