Thank you to all who attended our Parent Night. It was wonderful to see the interest and enthusiasm our parents have for their children's early education. We always welcome you to participate in our events and daily activities. If you could not make Parent Night and would like information on the evening, please feel free to ask your teachers. They would be happy to share with you anything you may have missed. Also, thank you to all the families that turned in their ASQ questionnaires. If you have not turned yours in yet, please do so as soon as you can. Teachers will be scoring the results soon and sharing those results with you in November during parent/teacher conferences unless they need to contact you earlier with any concerns.

The teachers will be contacting all parents by telephone during October to discuss just how well things are going for your child at school and any questions or concerns you may have. This is one of many opportunities we like to provide to parents to help build a positive working relationship between home and school.

Thank you to the parents that helped with picture day. Pictures should arrive 6-8 weeks from now.

We are excited once again to host our Fall Pumpkin Festival for all of our families on Saturday, October 14, from 9-11am. All current families of LCNS are encouraged to come. It promises to be a fun family event filled with games, pumpkin painting, tattoos, food and more! Please fill out a registration form prior to our event so that we make sure to have enough pumpkins in our pumpkin patch!

Halloween is our first holiday we celebrate together at LCNS and we want it to be fun for all. The 3's classes will celebrate Halloween on Monday, October 30th. The OMO and pre-k classes will celebrate on Tuesday, October 31st. **Children are encouraged to wear a costume but it is not required for anyone who is not comfortable wearing one.** We will begin each class with a wonderful costume parade and we hope our parents will stay and cheer us on. After the parade, we will continue with a typical preschool day. We will **not** trick or treat in our classrooms so we ask that parents **not** send anything for the children to pass out to their individual friends. However, we will have a party in each of our classrooms during the last half hour of class. Teachers will have sign up sheets in the rooms for parents to bring paper goods, drinks, and special party snacks. Some healthy ideas for party snacks that the children enjoy are: cheese and crackers; bagels and cream cheese; fruit; veggies; and yogurt. **Please remember homemade items or anything with nuts, or processed in a facility with nuts, are NOT allowed.** Parents are encouraged and welcome to attend the parties.
